Reading at home!

We change books once a week – however, please ensure your child has their book in school every day as they can be asked to read more than once a week.

Spare clothes

Please provide your child with spare clothes clearly labelled that can stay on their peg in case of any accidents. If your child goes home in spare Nursery clothes, please wash them and return them as soon as possible.

Water Bottles and Snack

Children are permitted to have water bottles in school filled with WATER ONLY. Please write their name on it.

Mathematics

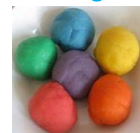
We will be exploring number rhymes, how quantities change when something is taken away and if there are more or fewer objects. Built into our topic we will be using positional language of in, on and under.
