Writing for Different Audiences

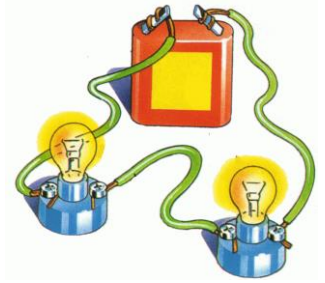
We will be exploring how we can use technology to help us write for different audiences.

We will be building on our knowledge of light, magnets and how the ear works. We will also be exploring how switches work within a circuit.



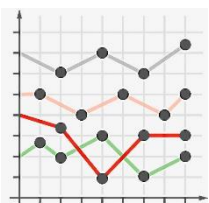
