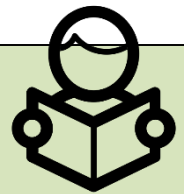
Water Bottles

Reading improves writing skills, maths attainment and concentration abilities, as well as children's well-being, creativity and empathy.

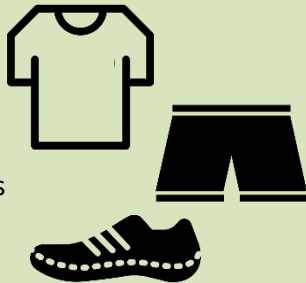
Your child can read independently or with a family member. When an adult is reading with your child, we encourage you to have a conversation about what has been read and question each other about the choices the author has made to support your child's comprehension skills.

Our school expects that children **read at home 5 times per week (for at least 10 minutes each time)**. Please ensure that you are signing and dating your child's reading record.

Reading records and books must be brought to school every day.

On PE days, children must bring their PE kit in a bag.



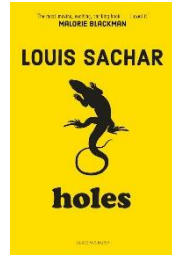
History *Vikings*

Through our history lessons, we will learn about the Tudors, including notable figures from history such as King Henry VIII, Mary I and Queen Elizabeth I.



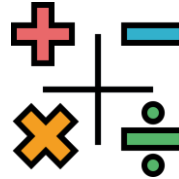
English *Holes*

Maths *Number and Measurement*

This term we will be focusing on multiplication and division, fractions, decimals and percentages, and perimeter and area.



Science *Biology, Chemistry and Physics*

This term, we will expand our knowledge of Biology, Physics and Chemistry. In Biology, we will learn about the circulatory system. In Chemistry, we will learn about reversible and irreversible reactions. In Physics, we will learn about light and sound.

This term we will be focusing on developing our strength, speed and agility through Handball. Children will dribble, throw, catch, jump, shoot, sprint, score, save and steal!

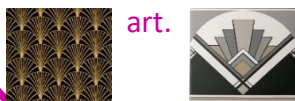
R.E *Green Religion*
