On PE days, children must come to school in PE kit and will stay in it all day. Therefore, please make sure it is weather appropriate!

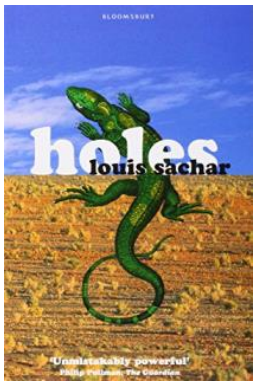


English

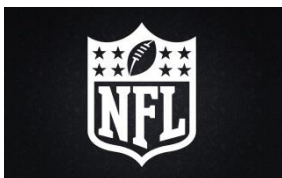
