Thanks for letting school know that your child has suspected symptoms of COVID-19 (Coronavirus). As your child has symptoms of coronavirus your child and all those who live in your household must self-isolate until you know their result. The attached poster also contains useful advice.

What is self-isolation?

Self-isolation is when you do not leave your home because you have or might have coronavirus (COVID-19). This helps stop the virus spreading to other people.

- do not go to work, school or public places – work from home if you can
- do not go on public transport or use taxis
- do not go out to get food and medicine – order it online or by phone, or ask someone to bring it to your home
- do not have visitors in your home, including friends and family – except for people providing essential care
- do not go out to exercise – exercise at home or in your garden, if you have one
