Dear Parents and Carers,

With just over a week to go until we break up, Friday 18th December will be our last day in school, I thought it important to let you know of our arrangements in terms of COVID-19 cases during the school holidays. These are as follows:

- For the first 6 days after teaching ends (up to and including 24th December), if a pupil or staff member tests positive for COVID-19, having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school is asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school. You should do this by contacting the school by email: lewisstreet.primaryschool@salford.gov.uk
- Where a pupil or staff member tests positive, having developed symptoms more than 48 hours after being in school, the school should not be contacted. Parents and carers should follow contact tracking instruction proved by NHS track and trace.
