Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back everyone! It is great to have all our children back in school and settling well into the school routines. Thank you for your kind words of thanks and support during this time.

As ever, our main focus remains the safety of our school community and your child's education. We will continue to deliver a full and balanced curriculum, which provides emotional support as well as academic support. We will also be sharing reminders of the expectations for keeping safe in school with the children on a daily basis. Please remember that, even though schools are open, we are still in National Lockdown and, therefore, we all need to continue to follow the Stay at Home guidance. In light of this and our school Risk Assessment, we are asking that, for drop-offs and pick-ups, children are accompanied by one adult only; that all adults wear a face covering (unless exempt) and socially distance.

Attendance and Punctuality

All children are expected to attend school every day. If your child is unable to attend school due to illness, please telephone the school office before 9.00a.m. Where possible, please arrange doctor/dentist appointments outside school hours.

Please continue to inform us if your child or a member of your household displays symptoms and ensure that you isolate in line with the Government guidance until you receive the results of a test.

Parking

The roads and pavements outside school are now very busy. In the interests of everyone's safety, may we remind you to avoid parking on the zigzag and double yellow lines. Thank you.

Uniform

Please ensure that your child is in the correct uniform every day: Navy blue jumper/cardigan; plain white shirt or polo shirt; grey/black trousers/skirt; plain black school shoes/trainers (no coloured soles). PE kits can continue to be worn when it is your child's PE day. Whilst the weather is still unsettled, please ensure that your child has a jumper and coat in school, with their name clearly labelled.

Remote Learning

We will be continuing to use our remote learning platforms in school and the children will share examples of their work. Please continue to take the time to look at what your child is learning on Tapestry, SeeSaw and Google Classrooms and add your comments – we all love to read them!
